

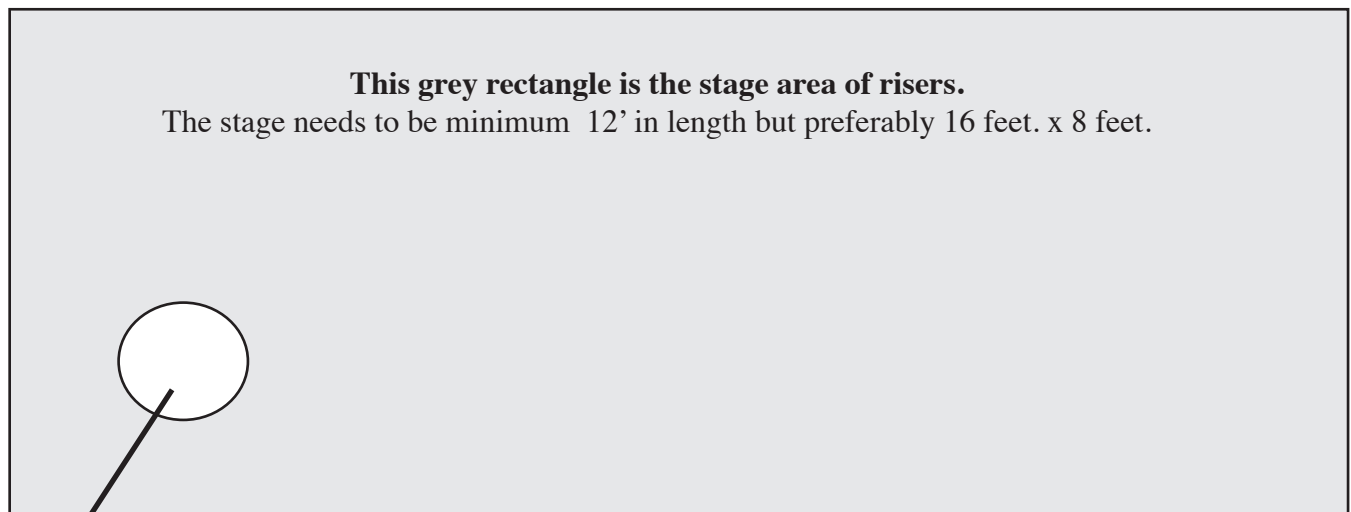
## Dr. Rick Brinkman: Stage Set Up Diagram



**THE SCREEN:** The screen usually needs to be a 12-15 foot screen. Centered behind the stage is preferred, but if your logistics require it to be in the corner that's ok. In that case a long VGA cord needs to be provided so my computer can still be on stage.

**SCREEN**



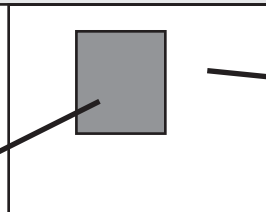
**BARSTOOL**

### **LCD PROJECTOR**

Can be located wherever it needs to be to project a proper image.

My presentation will be run from my computer using my wireless mouse. I just need a standard VGA connection to attach to computer and a powerstrip.

The computer needs to be on stage or in front of it.



### **SMALL TABLE**

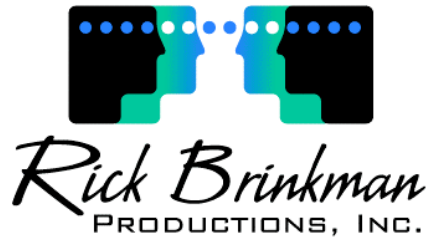
This square or round table no bigger than 3' x 3' table for the computer which will attach to the lcd projector. The table and computer can be on the stage or in front of the stage. The LCD projector can share the table with the computer or be in a separate location as needed.



**MICROPHONE:** For programs under 2 hours please provide a wireless handheld mic. For longer programs a wireless lavelier mic is preferred.
